## Digi Software and Drivers

### About the CD-Based Product Documentation

User documentation is provided on the Access Resource CD in HTML format. Digi recommends viewing this documentation with Internet Explorer 4.0 (or later) or Netscape Navigator 3.0 (or later).

Hardware installation cards, which are provided with most Digi adapters, are duplicated on the CD in Adobe PDF format. To view or print this documentation, you must have the Adobe Acrobat Reader installed on your system. You can download the reader from the Adobe web site.

**Note:** Some hardware installation cards are legal-sized documents (14" x 8.5"). If you want to print PDF documents this size on letter-sized paper (11" x 8.5"), you must specify "fit to page" in the Acrobat print function.

### Program Options

To make it easier for you to find what you need on the CD, Digi provides a program that automates tasks. From the program, you can do the following:

- Install software
- View release notes, product documentation, and information on Digi partner products
- Access the Digi web site
- Register your product online

## Using the Access Resource CD

To use the Access Resource CD, do the following:

1. Click Documentation
2. Choose appropriate product.
3. Review documentation before you begin Setup.

### About the Release Notes

Release notes are provided for each driver and software package and for the CD. To access the release notes, choose an operating system, hardware, software, and View Release Notes. To access release notes on the CD, choose About Digi Access Resource and Release Notes.

### Accessing the CD in Microsoft Windows NT, Windows 2000 or Windows 95/98/Me

1. Sign on as the administrator.
2. Place the CD in the system CD drive.
3. If autorun is not enabled, launch the CD menu program by choosing Start > Run, browsing to the root of the CD, and choosing setup.exe.
4. When the program appears, make your selections.

### Accessing the CD in Novell NetWare

The CD menu program does not run on a NetWare server. For NetWare systems, however, you can do any of the following:

- To view the documentation and print or view release notes, use a Windows client. Follow the procedure, "Accessing the CD in Microsoft Windows NT, Windows 2000 or Windows 95/98."
- To install drivers from a NetWare server, see "Installing a Driver from the NetWare Console."
- To install drivers from a Windows client, see "Installing a Novell Driver from a Windows Client."
